**1 JOE WELDEN**— usually works with acrylic paints plus collage elements and other media. Jazz musicians and city scenes dominate most of his work.  
...Studio is at the corner of Grow Ave / Church St. and Maple St, one half block south of the hospital. Studio is at the 1st house on the south corner of Maple St. Tall pine trees on west side of studio – we're in the back. When proceeding south on 29, Joe is on your right; when proceeding north on 29 he's on your left. (Grow Ave & Church Street are the same. **2 BETTY BRYDEN AND TOM CANOUSE**—  
**TOM CANOUSE** translates his fondness for objects and occupants in our environment in his wood carvings and woodblock prints. He also carves and shapes utilitarian wood objects as personal adornment and household implements. Tom will demonstrate carving on Monday from 12-3.  
**BETTY BRYDEN** is a collagist and watercolor painter whose works have won numerous awards and appear in many prestigious collections. Her art captures a moment in time as a landscape or single object. The unifying elements in her work are handmade and altered papers and the distillation of imagery. Betty will demonstrate the paste paper method of altering paper on Monday from 12-3, weather permitting.

**4 RODRICA TILLEY**— "Vivid, lively and fresh" describes Rodrica's landscape pastel paintings. Orange dahlias, violet-grey thunderheads, peaceful ochre plowed fields are typical subjects of this nationally published and widely collected artist. **5** There are two artists at the **Holy Name of Mary Parish Center**, ("Green House"), 60 S. Main St., Montrose, across from the Holy Name of Mary Catholic Church. At the red light in Montrose take PA 29 South, ¼ mile. House is on the right. Wheelchair accessible.

**RITA EDDY**—Rita will be using a variety of techniques as she works in watercolors, pastels, and acrylics. Painting and greeting cards of landscapes, gardens, nature, and exotic travel scenes predominate her exhibit. "Trees in Nature" will be featured this year. **14 ARCHIE JOHNSON & RUTH COHEN / MUD AND FIRE POTTERS**— Archie and Ruth continue to explore contemporary and traditional forms. Their distinctive functional and decorative ware and wheel-thrown sculptures have a strength and charm reflecting Asian, Western, and Jamaican/ African roots. Their current work features the intriguing textures, Shino glazes and earth tones characteristic of wood firings. On Monday a variety of forms will be thrown and altered.  
...From Montrose, PA 706 west to PA 167 N. Take North road (4007) to PA 267 S. Left on 267 to Friendsville Rd.(4014), turn right, then continue straight onto PA 858N to Bowbridge Rd. Turn right, go 1 mile to #1552. From Choconut Take PA 267 to Stanley Lake Rd to Bowbridge Rd. Turn right and follow dirt road 4.5 miles to #1552. - 15 LESLI & KIRK VANZANDBERGEN**—are professional commercial photographers who are using the latest digital photography equipment and techniques to produce award winning photography in a beautiful rural Pennsylvania setting. They are .9 mile on the left. - 16 CHARLES RANDALL**— As a boy Charles spent summers at Silver Lake, and retired to this area 20 years ago. Landscapes in watercolor are his primary interest. His paintings are impressions of local hills, streams, and farms through the seasons. Charles will demonstrate watercolor technique at 2pm Monday. ...From Montrose follow PA 167 north for about 8 miles before ascending a long gradual hill bordered on the left by extensive open fields. Pass an active dairy farm at the crest of hill. 20 ft. past this dairy note the white mailbox (#3009) on the right. Randall's studio is in the barn behind the house. ...From Binghamton take Pennsylvania or Park Ave south through Hawleyton and follow this road as it climbs out of the valley. - 17 GEORGE AND BEN MANNS**— Father and son woodworkers, create unique and functional home furnishings. Though they each have an individual style, they are both inspired by the abundance of nature that surrounds their home. On Monday George will use chainsaws, grinders, sanders, rasps and more to shape pieces of wood into furniture parts. ...From Montrose, 706W to Lawton, right on 267N. Go 2 miles, turn left onto Irish Hill Road, which turns to the right at top of hill. Shop is on right, 4 miles from that turn. From NY border 267 S for 8 miles, right onto Friendsville Hill Rd. - 18 TOM RICHIE**— Tom brings wood to life in finely detailed and textured carvings inspired by nature -- waterfowl in decorative and working styles, shorebirds, and songbirds, all in nature's subtle coloring. On Monday he will be showing details on beginning block of wood from the point of detailing with burner and dremel to the painting. ....From the north, follow S.R. 267 south from Lawton, PA, (Lawton is west of Montrose on S.R. 706) about 5 miles to a Citgo station at 4 corners. Turn right here and follow this road 1 mile to the Retta Church. Turn left and proceed to the 5th house on the right. From the south (U.S. 6), follow S.R. 267 north from Meshoppen to the Citgo station, where you turn left and follow the above directions at Retta Church. 570-869-1026 / crichie@epix.net
- 19 STEVE CONLEY**—Steve creates large scale paintings utilizing a method of cut stencils and acrylic spray on linen canvas. He is currently working on a series titled "Animal Behavior". Take Exit 206 off of Rt. I-81 and follow Rt. 374 past Elk Mtn. to Dimock Corners where you turn left onto SR2034 and go exactly 1.3 miles to my driveway on the right (the gate has number 137C on it). You will see two green buildings up in the field. 570-679-9454
- 21 KEN ELY / GOOD NEIGHBOR WALLS**— This year Ken will be building a new stone wall bordering the driveway entrance to property that he and his wife own in Dimock Township. It will be a retaining wall composed of fieldstones of varying sizes and shapes, and its purpose will be to add definition to the drive's edges and to create an easily accessed area for plantings such as perennials, ground cover, or ferns, since it is a wooded site. To visit Ken's project, follow Route 29 to Dimock (between Montrose and Springville). At Baker's Garage in Dimock, turn east onto S.R. 3023. Follow this road (toward Hop Bottom and Nicholson) for 2.2 miles from Route 29. The property is on the left. Ken enjoys talking with visitors about building technique, geology, and history of stone walls in our region. He was awarded a Fellowship in 2009 from the Pennsylvania Council on the Arts, and conducts workshops and presentations as well as building and restoring fieldstone walls.
